

Unusually high quality, very usual for Bolidt systems



While 'usual' once meant basic, today luxury features and functions set the standard for what's 'usual'. Mobile phone? Sure, as long as it includes radio, megapixel camera, voice recognition, Bluetooth and iPhone. Fast Food? Multifunctional design packaging, gifts, healthy menus, variants for large and small hungers, typical Dutch Fast Food products. Something to [drink](#)? Make a choice: regular, caffeine-free, light, light caffeine-free, sugar-free, lemon or vanilla. Television? Fifty-plus channels is no longer an exception. [Parking facilities](#)... The trend is the same. It's no longer a matter of finding a site, building an entrance and exit, painting some lines and installing a payment terminal. Heavy demands are made on the design and layout. Modern architecture, user-friendliness, hygiene, optimum safety, and ample, clear route marking; the list of requirements is long indeed.

That goes not only for new facilities; existing garages also have to go with the flow. Despite still looking pretty sharp, a large part of Claxonate garage in Purmerend was recently given a makeover. Users are still driving over synthetic systems from Bolidt dating from 1997, when Claxonate was newly-built. The management are pleasantly surprised at how good it still looks after 13 years. Just a few small wear spots, in all scarcely 1% of the total surface, betray the age of the finish. This proves yet again that spending more to ensure a sturdy, high [quality](#) wearing course yields a generous return on the investment. Claxonate has been resurfaced in one or two places with a wearing course, but mainly the specific colour layers have been repaired with Bolicoat® 50 to freshen up the route marking. The roof was not coated during the original work in 1997, but Claxonate did decide to have this done a short time later. The natural substrate was too slippery and the grip provided by the Boligrip® 1250 system ensured the necessary safety. A decade later, the roof still looks astonishingly good. Luxury may have become 'usual', Bolidt systems continue to be 'unusually good'!
