

PRIVACY- AND COOKIE STATEMENT

Bolidt Kunststoftoepassing B.V. respects the privacy of the visitors to our website and we will ensure that the personal information you provide to us is treated confidentially. All processing of personal data is carried out in accordance with the applicable statutory requirements.

Purposes of data processing

We process personal data for the purposes of entering into and carrying out agreements and managing the relationships arising from those agreements, including conducting activities to increase our client base.

If you complete a contact or registration form on our website or send us an email, the data you send us will be retained for as long as required to fully process the form or answer the email, given the nature of the form or the content of the email.

Clicking behaviour and visitor data

The website collects general visitor data. This may specifically involve the registration of your computer's IP address, your username, if any, the time of retrieval and data sent by your browser, which may be used for statistical analyses of the visitor and clicking behaviour on our website. This enables us, among other things, to optimise the functioning of the website.

Where possible, Bolidt Kunststoftoepassing B.V. anonymises any data it discloses. No data are disclosed to third parties outside the Bolidt group.

Google Analytics

We use Google Analytics to monitor how users use our website and to monitor the effectiveness of our AdWords adverts that appear next to Google search results. The information thus obtained, including your computer's IP address, is transferred to and stored on servers in the United States by Google. Google uses this information to monitor how our website is used, to report to us about our website, and to provide its advertisers with information about the effectiveness of their campaigns.
